The breadth GPA is calculated as the GPA of breadth (and core, if it applies) courses taken within 24 months of completion of degree requirements, excluding the final semester.

Do **not** include those courses taken in the **final semester**. Calculate your breadth GPA accordingly on the last row. Your breadth courses are considered for your written comprehensive examination.
